

# **RENAMING RW WILCOCKS BUILDING**

## **GUIDELINES FOR NOMINATIONS AND NAMING PROCESS**

### **Nominations and naming process**

- A call for nominations will be sent from the Registrar's Office including guidelines and a nomination form.
- All nominations will be collated and submitted to the Committee for the Naming of Buildings, Venues and Other Facilities/Premises (hereafter the "Naming Committee")
- The Naming Committee will draft a short list from the nominations received and present it to the Rectorate for consideration
- The Rectorate will submit the proposed name to the Executive Committee of Council for approval as per the current Naming Policy.

### **Timeline for nominations**

- Nominations are open for 30 days from the first invitation.

### **Who may nominate**

- Registered students at SU
- All permanent or full-time staff members at SU
- Members of community structures<sup>3</sup> represented on the IF of SU.


The Naming Committee, at the discretion of the members, may extend the nomination process and seek additional information about nominations from nominators should the need arise.

When submitting a nomination, nominators are encouraged to consider the following:

- The University's commitment to the ideal of an inclusive, world-class university in and for Africa<sup>4</sup>;
  - The University's commitment to adopting new visual symbols that allow for the inclusion of a variety of expressions, stories, identities and histories;<sup>5</sup>
  - The distinctive character of the University as an institution of higher education;
  - The commitment of the University to the advancement of academic integrity, academic freedom and freedom of scientific research, responsibility, accountability, ethical behaviour, fairness and transparency<sup>6</sup>; and
  - The potential for the process to inform teaching and learning and serve as an opportunity for community-wide learning.
