Afrikaans Language Learning 289 **Afrikaans Second Language**

Only students who passed ALL 189 may register for this module. No mother-tongue speakers of Afrikaans may take this module.

The module is focused on equipping students to:

- understand and utilise the main characteristics of a variety of Afrikaans texts and way in which these characteristics contribute to meaning;
- further develop and use communicative language skills;
- apply and utilise strategic listening and reading skills;
- develop and use oral skills; and
- develop and use literary skills.

Remarks

1. Visual media and film studies make up a substantial part of the module.

Assessment method

ALL 289 uses a system of flexible assessment. The final mark is composed of all tests, essays and assignments completed during the year. Students do not write an exam at the end of the year, instead they write four compulsory tests during the course of the year. Students are informed in writing at the start of the year regarding the method used to calculate the final mark and receive regular feedback on their progress during the course of the module.
