Honours Afrikaans and Dutch

The programme consists of a compulsory research module and six modules chosen from a list of electives. The programme runs for one academic year and is presented in lecture format.

Admission requirements

- A BA degree with Afrikaans *or* Afrikaans and Dutch as major.
- An average mark of 60% in the major needed for entry into the programme.

Modules

Compulsory module: Research Assignment

Choose **one** of the following modules:

- Formal Afrikaans Linguistics
- Literary Theory and Afrikaans Literature

Choose **five** of the following modules, excluding the module you chose above:

- Afrikaans Text Analysis
- Afrikaans and/or Dutch Drama and Film Studies (screenings occur outside normal teaching hours)
- Afrikaans Lexicographic Theory
- Afrikaans Poetry
- Afrikaans Prose
- Applied Afrikaans Linguistics
- Creative Writing (subject to a selection process)
- Linguistic Citizenship and Afrikaans
- Literary Theory and Afrikaans Literature
- Methodology of Afrikaans Language Acquisition
- Modern Dutch Literature
