The programme includes 10 modules, practical assignments, and a professional report reflecting workplace experience and challenges. Modules include:

- Financial Leadership & Governance Managing Health Technology
- Strategy, marketing & communication
- Project Management

Quality Improvement & clinical Governance

The target group is senior managers in health care organisations, in the public and private sectors; clinicians and health professionals who manage health care practices.

Eligibility: Applicants should have a 3-year Bachelor's degree in a relevant discipline (health sciences, economic and management sciences, social sciences), on NQF Level 7 with relevant workplace experience, demonstrated academic ability and proficiency in English. An appropriate current or planned employment position in management recommended.

Closing date for applications: 31 August for International & 30 September for South African students

The programme extends over two years and is presented on a part-time basis.
