
ARRIVING BY AIR:

Arriving at the Cape Town International Airport

Cape Town International Airport is located approximately 12 kilometres from Tygerberg. When hiring a car use

the following GPS Directions to Tygerberg Campus. Visitors are responsible for covering their airfares, local travel, travel insurance (highly recommended), VISA (if

applicable), airport shuttles and any other incidentals.



It is important that participants check passport and visa requirements for South Africa in due time before departure.

A scanned copy of your passport must be provided.


