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Constitutional Responsibilities

According to the student constitution (Chapt. 4, Section 36 (8) a and b), my constitutional

Portfolio Overview

to help them ask the right questions and refine their problem-definition process to aid them in

data collection and problem definition.

3) The manager is also expected to aid SRC members and managers; and to act in a supportive

manner with other portfolios as necessary and within reason.

Term II Overview

During the second term on the SRC I did my regular weekly **office duties** where we are open to inquiries from students. I also assisted in creating and collecting responses on Microsoft Teams for my

fellow SRC members.

I had a productive meeting with the Executive Committee to discuss potential projects that could

benefit the student body. One project which I am taking on is to get more information on how many



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students had to cancel their university placement for the sole reason of the lack of accommodation options in the area. This might give some insight into how the university can tackle this problem.

I have recently joined a **task team** mandated by student governance to collect data and compile a report on honorariums and funding structures within the university. We will have our first meeting within the coming weeks.

Plans for Next Term

The accommodation project and student governance task team are in the early stages so I will mainly focus on getting the ball rolling on these two matters. I plan to further collaborate with the executive committee and other SRC members to assist them in doing research into matters that they deem pressing.
