TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Research Papers

We kindly request that the **NuMeRI Node for Infection Imaging** be acknowledged in research papers where data generated in the laboratory were used.

Cancellation Policy:

Please inform the centre as soon as a cancellation arises so that we can adjust our planning accordingly. If cancellation of a radiopharmaceutical dose (if ordered through the NII) is no longer possible, the user will be liable for this cost. The typical cut-off time for cancellation of radiopharmaceutical orders is 12 pm the day preceding the scan.

Late Arrivals:

Given that we work with radioactive tracers which decay over time, any delays in commencing booked studies on time potentially impact our ability to perform scans later in the day (knock-on effect). While every effort will be made to accommodate them, the NII reserves the right to cancel participants or patients who arrive late. Please ensure your participants or patients know when they should be at our centre (90 minutes before their scan slot), and how to get there.

Scan Delays and Scheduling Adjustments:

For a variety of reasons (incl. radiotracer production failures and late deliveries, scanner downtime, sick patients) that are outside our control, exact scan start times may be delayed or in rare cases, may need to be rescheduled for another day. Our staff will keep researcher and referral clients informed in such cases.

Standard Terms and Conditions

1. Ownership of the data and/or samples provided by the client shall remain so vested.
2. All data and/or samples provided by the Client will be treated as confidential.
3. Any analysis report prepared by SU shall become the property of the Client after payment.
