KATZ, David Brock (Military Science)

General J.C. Smuts and His First World War in Africa 1914 -1917

The First World War represents Smuts at the apex of his active military career. His role as a general is a contested history and remains an enigma to historians, past and present. This study drilled down into a neglected aspect of Smuts' character – Smuts the warrior – and placed his generalship under a microscope using the Afrikaner Rebellion, the German South-West Africa and German East Africa First World War campaigns as a lens. His African campaigns capture the essence of Smuts the general. This study, based on archival sources, overcame several historiographical hurdles while unravelling the obfuscation clouding Smuts' military career.

SHAAMHULA, Victoria Loide (Military Science)

A proactive disaster risk reduction framework for recurring Efundja in the rural Cuvelai-Etosha basin, Northern Namibia

In the Cuvelai-Etosha basin, annual flooding (Efundja) destroys the livelihoods of rural communities, limits their mobility and negatively influences various aspects of their lives. This pioneering study elicited responses regarding coping mechanisms from the rural communities influenced by the Efundja and from their traditional leaders, as well as from local and national level disaster risk officials. Combining the voices of all relevant role-players, a proactive disaster risk reduction framework was developed. This framework will help the Namibian government to improve its existing response approach and highlights the importance of considering the voices of affected communities in disaster risk reduction strategies.

IAN VAN DER WAAG

Prof Ian van der Waag is recognised for his outstanding contribution to the growth and development of Military Science as an academic pursuit in South Africa, and for his contribution to South African military historiography, which he has mapped and contoured significantly over the past 25 years. Author of several books, he has shaped and given content to several new programmes offered at military colleges and defence academies in several countries; serves on the boards of various journals; has a busy slate of postgraduate students; works with colleagues transnationally in running research teams and producing output; and – among other things – is a Fellow of the Modern War Institute, at the US Military Academy, West Point, and a regional ambassador for the Western Front Association (UK). He is an NRF B2-rated researcher.
